DIYC COVID-19 Member/Guest Advisory & Protocols (4/29/2021)

USAGE & ACCESS GUIDELINES FOR DIYC CLUB PROPERTY AND EVENTS

(These guidelines are in addition to any issued by CDC, state or local authorities, though follow the most recent CDC and state guidelines published.)

- **If you or a guest feels sick**, has experienced COVID-19 symptoms within the past 14 days, or has within the past 14 days come into contact with someone who has COVID-19 (outside the role of medical professional), you or the guest should not come to the Club or race.
- **All who visit Club grounds or participate in racing in any role during this time should be aware of the potential risks associated with COVID-19.**
- **Per CDC Guidelines:**
 - **Outdoor** – Wear a mask and stay 6ft apart for unvaccinated people when attending a small, outdoor gathering with fully vaccinated and unvaccinated people, vaccinated people can remain unmasked.
 - **Indoor** – Wear a mask and stay 6ft apart for both unvaccinated and vaccinated people.
- **Sanitize your hands (with your own hand sanitizer) immediately upon arrival to the Club by land or sea**, after going to the restroom, before and after eating, and after coughing/sneezing.
- **The Clubhouse will fully open on 5/19.** Limited restroom usage on race nights is available from the Condo Association restrooms on the west side of the clubhouse until then. Bathrooms will be cleaned after racing. The deck will be open for all members and guests at this time.
- **A touchless thermometer which will be available from race committee upon request.**
- **While this guidance provides a way for racers, race committee and all those affiliated with DIYC to enjoy racing by limiting risk, all risks to participants cannot be eliminated.** Captains and boat owners are ultimately responsible for the safety of their crews and must determine if each crew member should be on board. Captains must require signed waivers from all crew members prior to racing.
